His last CD, "Everblue" was featured on several "Best of 2018" Blues lists and charts and has enjoyed worldwide radio airplay and recognition. Ekat Pereyra (Vocalist, Piano, Ukelele) appreciation for music began with her birth in St. Petersburg, Russia. With her parents being working musicians, At the age of 7, Ekat was accepted to one of St. Petersburg's schools of music and began her musical training. She has opened for Bad Company with Billy Spanton and the Ramblin' Train. She just completed another month-long multi-state tour as a lead vocalist with The Holiday Rock Orchestra "Twelve Twenty-Four" where she received standing ovations performing to "sold-out" theater venue crowds. She also performs with and has recorded two CDs (and two highly acclaimed Christmas Songs) and the new CD "JP & Ekat" with the JP Williams Blues Band, .

Heartbreak, true love, lost love, and bits of real life experiences are what comprises the music here. If the music comes from the heart, it will always encourage repeat listening. In the pandemic inspired remote tracking and assembly of these songs, Producer and Recording Engineer Lou Pereyra has worked hard to capture the strength and beauty of the music clearly and with honest emotion.
